

## Whats new in this booklet:

When we amended some of our Maidenhead routes in April, it was on the assumption that some services were going to be withdrawn, and we attempted to cover some of the gaps which would otherwise be without a service. Now that Services 8 and 16/16A are secured with some additional funding by Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead Council, we are making some further revisions to the route of Services 5 and 9 following customer feedback.

Service 5 - Minor timetable amendments.  
Rerouted from Grenfell Road via Boyn Hill Avenue, Boyn Hill Road and Wootton Way to rejoin the current route at Bath Road, no longer serving St Mark's Hospital. An additional bus stop will be placed on Wootton Way near the end of Badminton Road. An extra later service on Mondays to Saturdays with support from RBWM Council.

Service 7 - Minor timetable amendments in the morning peak period following customer feedback.  
An additional later weekday service from the town centre.

Service 8 - An additional earlier trip to Boulters Lock on weekdays.

Service 9 - Early morning services revised or retimed to avoid duplication with service 8. Most journeys will no longer serve Camley Gardens, Headington Road and Farm Road, nor Belmont Road and Gringer Hill as these areas are covered by Service 8. Instead most journeys on Service 9 will operate from Halifax Road via Halifax Way, Pinkneys Road, St Marks Crescent, Courthouse Road, All Saints Avenue, St Marks Road, Castle Hill to Frascati Way. However, Service 9 will continue to operate its current route on evenings and Sundays when Service 8 does not run.

Service 16/16A - Minor timetable changes to improve reliability. The journey from Windsor at 1105 will operate a different route to avoid being delayed by the Guard Change.

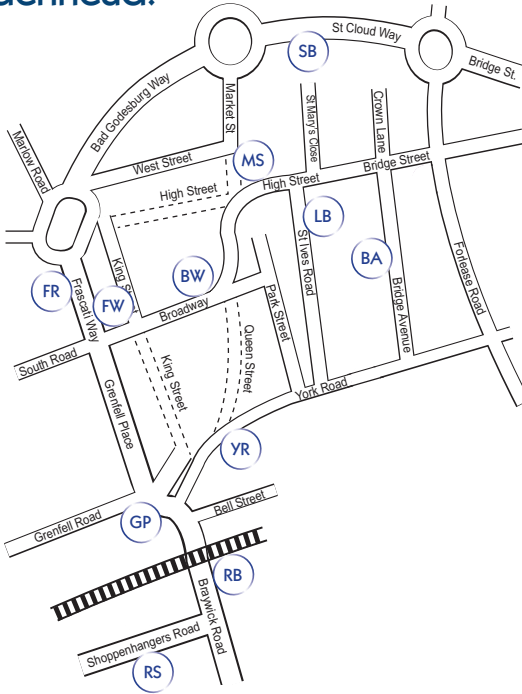
